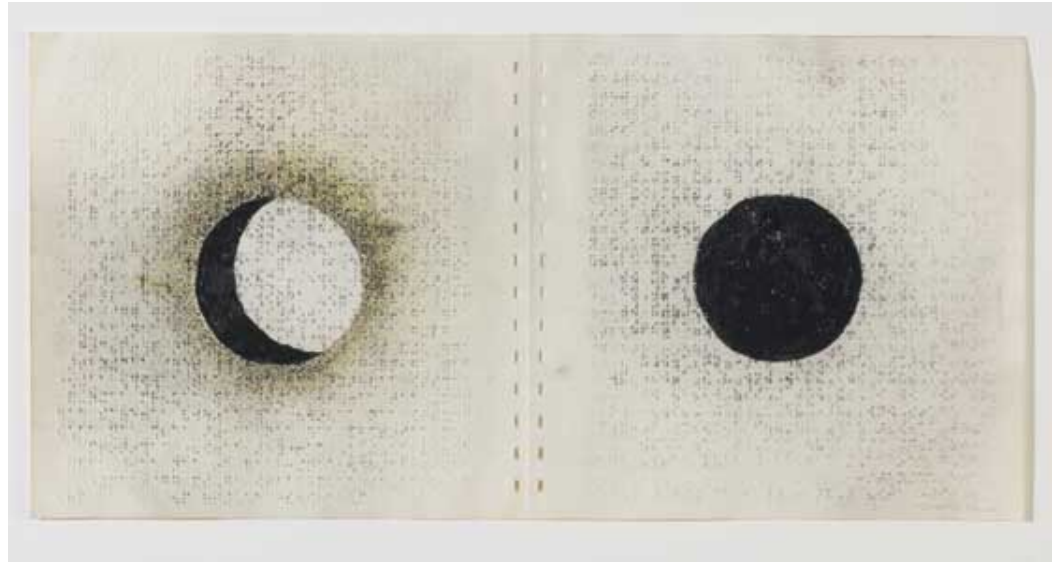

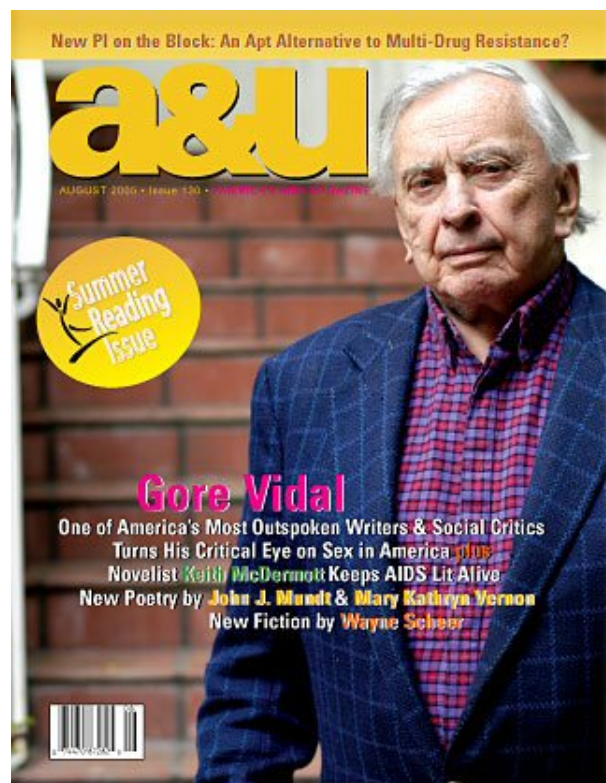
Thomas Somerville was named Director of Education at ArtisanWORKS Museum of

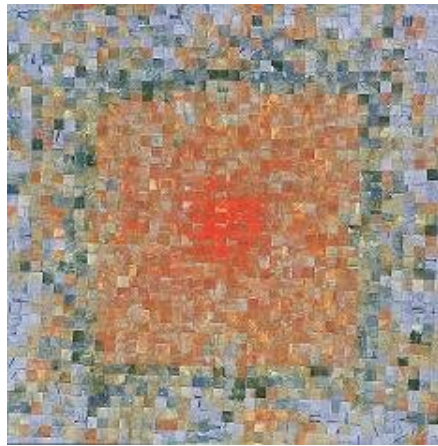
