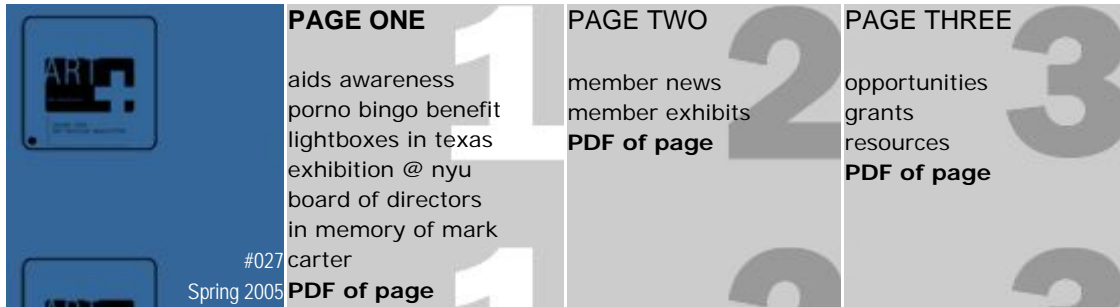

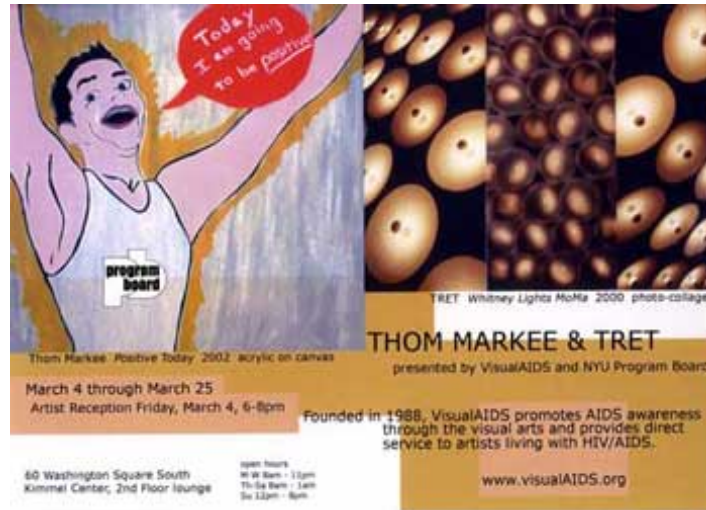
[Visual AIDS](#) Lightboxes in Texas
