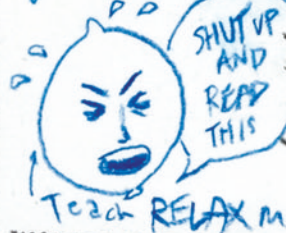

Teach RELAX MAN

- How does HIV spread through sex? **IGNORANCE**
- ✓ HIV is spread by HIV infection in blood and sexual fluids found in the man's penis and woman's vagina.
- ✓ Sexual fluids ^{cum} come before, during, and after orgasm.
- ✓ You can't spread HIV if there is no HIV infection.

- What is safe sex? **Showing some LOVE**
- ✓ Some sexual activity carries some risk of spreading HIV.
- ✓ To reduce risk make it difficult for HIV to get into your body.

SCARY!



- What is unsafe sex? **stupid**
- ✓ Unsafe sex has a high risk of spreading HIV when blood or sexual fluid touches soft, moist mucous membranes.
- ✓ Mucous membranes are found inside the rectum, vagina, mouth, nose, and the tip of the penis.
- ✓ Vaginal or rectal intercourse without protection is very unsafe. **AKA ASS**
- ✓ Sexual fluids enter the body and wherever the man's penis is inserted. It can cause small tears that can make HIV infection more likely.

WRAP UP

- ✓ HIV can enter the man's penis if it comes into contact with blood or vaginal fluids or has open sores.

- What is safer sex? **SMART**
- ✓ Beware of your body and your partner's. Cuts, sores, and bleeding gums increase risk.
- ✓ Use a barrier to prevent contact with blood or sexual fluids.
- ✓ The most common artificial barrier for men is a condom.
- ✓ Lubricants can reduce the chance of a condom breaking.
- ✓ Be sure to use water based lubricants. Oil based lubricants like vaseline can damage condoms.
- ✓ Oral sex is a lower risk activity for HIV transmission.

- ✓ To be safer, try using a flavored condom. **cherry?**
- What are safe activities?
- ✓ Abstinence is totally safe... **AND LONELY, get real!**
- ✓ Sex between two individuals who are not infected with HIV and are not having sex or sharing needles with anyone else.
- ✓ Fantasy, masturbation, sexy talk, hugging, kissing, and massage.
